AllinWall is a multifunctional modular storage system and an ideal solution for keeping and storing documents of different formats.

The *AllinWall* office storage system is composed of walls, panels/barriers, shelves and folders. *AllinWall* sturdily divides the office space and allows users take out documents and files from both sides. The folders can be removed from the system. A distinct marking system allows easy differentiation of folders. The folders accommodate documents sized A2, A3 and A4, as well as two types of rolls. There are also presentations boards that accommodate plans, sketches and so on. *AllinWall* also includes decorative elements such as vases, lamps and an aquarium, as well as all necessary fixing elements.

AllinWall was designer Karina Eganyan's final university project and it was created in collaboration with Nayada Company, which supported the work and research.
